How to receive the vaccine

Safe and effective COVID-19 vaccines are a promising development that can help protect us from the virus. By choosing to be vaccinated when it's your turn, you'll be doing your part to help us return to normal.

Kaiser Permanente has been approved as a COVID-19 vaccine provider in Colorado. As an approved provider, we will administer the vaccine to Kaiser Permanente members and non-members according to the phases set by Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE). Please visit the **CDPHE COVID-19 website** to learn more. We encourage members and non-members to register to get the COVID-19 vaccine wherever there is availability.

Follow these steps to request a COVID-19 vaccine through Kaiser Permanente

Kaiser Permanente members:

- 1. Fill out the COVID-19 vaccine sign-up e-visit at kp.org/covidvaccine/colorado.
- 2. Or complete a short questionnaire by calling 1-844-951-1932.

If you are not currently a Kaiser Permanente member follow these steps:

- 1. Get your Health Record Number (HRN) by completing a brief questionnaire at **kp.org/covidvaccine/colorado**. You will be notified of your HRN within 24 hours.
- 2. Use this HRN to register for your secure Kaiser Permanente account at **kp.org/register**.
- 3. Once you have completed your registration, sign up for the waitlist by filling out the COVID-19 vaccine sign-up e-visit through your secure Kaiser Permanente account.

Check your position in line

Once you sign-up, you do not need to take any further action. 48 hours after registration, you can call **1-844-951-1932** to hear your position in line anytime you'd like. We will hold your place in our virtual line and notify you by e-mail, text, or phone when it is your turn to schedule an appointment.
